Permit Requirements

Camping permits must be prominently displayed on each unit. Units not displaying a valid registration card will be subject to the penalties set out in Traffic Bylaw 16-2015, and the Parks Bylaw 21-2013 as amended or rescinded and replaced from time to time.

Permit holders must comply with all existing bylaws.

Camping

- Camping units on parking lots must not be parked in a location that obstructs traffic signs or reduces sightline visibility for other traffic.
- There will be no dumping of grey or black water.
- Must camp in designated area. Any damage to Strathcona County property will be repaired immediately and at the leases expense.

Litter

- No person shall leave any garbage, or litter in a park except in a receptacle designed for such use.

Noise

- All parks within the county, unless otherwise indicated by signage, shall be closed to the public between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Fires

- No person shall start or permit to be started any fire in a parking lot or park unless it is confined to fireplaces or appliances provided by Strathcona County for that purpose.
- No person shall start a fire in a park when there is a declared fire ban.

If any or all of the permit requirements are not followed, this application and associated permits could be deemed null and void, and the applicant could be liable to charges for violation of Traffic Bylaw 16-2015, the Parks Bylaw 21-2013, and all other applicable bylaws.

The applicant shall indemnify and save harmless Strathcona County and its agents from any and all loss, damage, actions and claims which the said County and/or Agent may be put to suffer, by reason of any activities associated with this application.
